San José residents and business were enrolled in SJCE's GreenSource service in February 2019*. You can also upgrade to TotalGreen and receive 100% renewable energy.

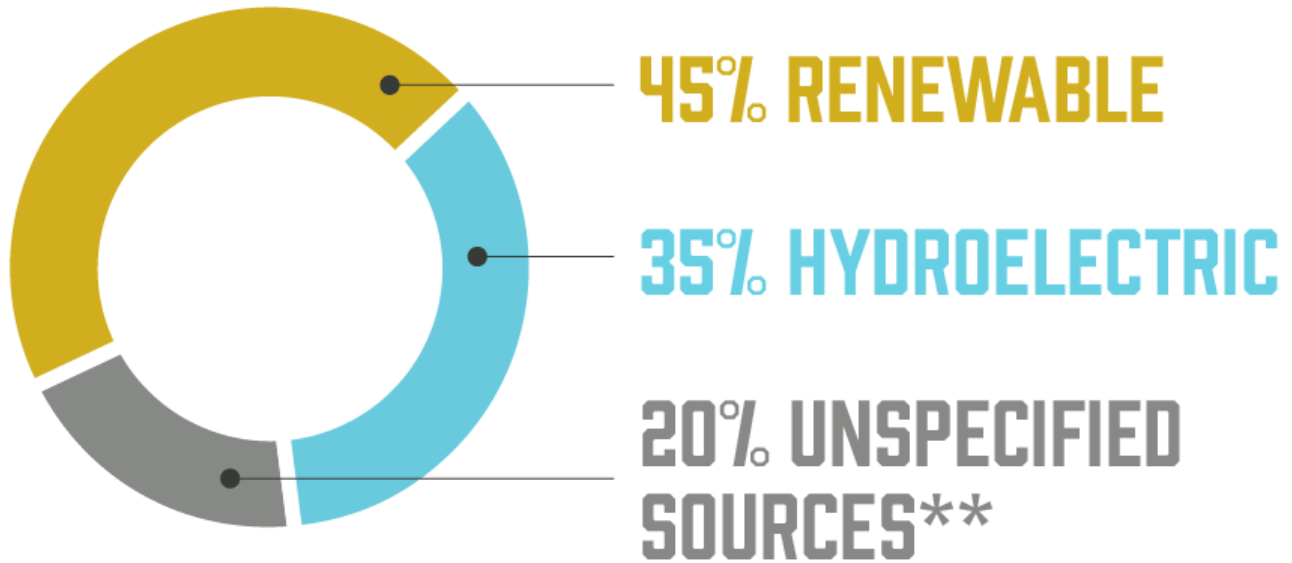
GREENSOURCE

Customers in the City of San José with existing PG&E accounts were automatically enrolled in GreenSource in February 2019*. Your electricity is generated from renewable sources (<https://www.sanjosecleanenergy.org/whats-clean-energy>) such as wind and solar, and from carbon-free sources such as hydropower. GreenSource rates are cheaper than PG&E (<https://www.sanjosecleanenergy.org/residential-rates>) generation rates.

***Unspecified sources aren't traceable to a specific generation facility, such as electricity traded through open-market transactions. They may include renewables and hydroelectric.*

You can upgrade to TotalGreen at any time to receive 100% renewable energy.

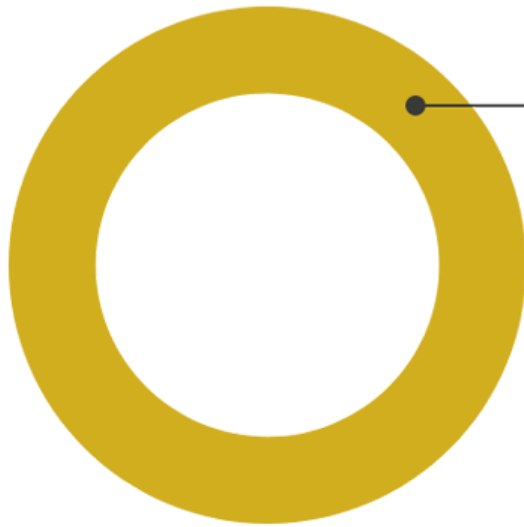

ROOFTOP SOLAR

Commercial customers: SJCE has an easy and attractive program for solar and other distributed electricity generation systems (wind, biogas and fuel cells) for commercial customers.

Residential Customers: We expect to enroll residential customers in 2020, when we can be certain you will receive a fair value. If you currently have solar, you won't automatically be enrolled in SJCE's standard GreenSource service. But you can enroll early by upgrading to TotalGreen (<http://www.sanjosecleanenergy.org/totalgreen>), our 100% renewable option.

OPT OUT – PG&E POWER MIX*

If you choose, you can opt out of San José Clean Energy and remain entirely with PG&E service. However, you won't benefit from cleaner and cheaper electricity nor participate in a locally controlled energy program that benefits our community.

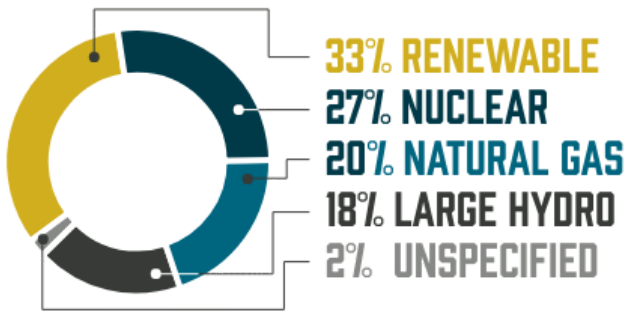
There's no charge to switch to remain with PG&E before your SJCE service starts** or within 180 days after service starts. And if you later decide that SJCE is a good choice for you, we'll be happy to welcome you back!
