Dear Tim,

In 2019, the Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board (Caltrain) authorized Google, LLC to include property owned by Caltrain within the boundaries of Google's Downtown West Mixed-Use Plan. As our team has previously advised the City, Caltrain is no longer part of Google's project and therefore formally requests its property be removed from the Downtown West Mixed-Use Plan area. Caltrain also withdraws the previously submitted universal planning application, and the authorization granted to Google, LLC, to process that application on behalf of Caltrain.

Caltrain plans to submit an independent development proposal to the City for its Diridon Station adjacent property, and looks forward to collaborating with the City on that process.
