

	Thank you for the conversation this afternoon, and sharing insights about the Copenhagen example.
	Our goal is for persons travel through the area to find well-developed trail or bikeway connections to major sites like the Guadalupe River Park and Train Station.
	With that in mind, I wanted to note that your question about a Ramp from San Fernando Street is a good one. We haven't studied it, but that's due to lack of time rather than an indication of infeasibility.
	For northbound travel, it might work well to have people approach San Fernando Street in order to access Class IV Bikeways tor each the station, or travel east to the Guadalupe River and downtown.

	Please let me know if you want to discuss this topic further. I'm interested in exploring options as I know that there's a high expectation for continuity of bike / ped facilities along the Los Gatos Creek corridor.
