Unfortunately, I don't have photos in the environmental review folder either.

There are some photos of existing conditions with conceptual renderings of the proposed project from West Julian Street Looking Southwest, Bird Avenue at I-280 Looking Northwest, and Cahill Park Looking East in the project description of the DEIR with conceptual renderings of the proposed project, but none of the existing conditions photos specifically show the parking lots.
