Record Webpage](#)] and search for the part of Appendix G in which the document you are seeking is shown as being included.” Then you can substitute the attached version of Appendix G0 for what is on the EIR webpage. I have revised the attached to use identifiers that correspond to how the Admin. Record webpage identifies the different parts of Appendix G (e.g., “Appendix G, Part 3”).

Shannon, David: I have now uploaded the appendices files to the ceqasubmit.opr.ca.gov website. One change I decided to make is that I opted NOT to upload all the 3 GB worth of HazMat files to the OPR site, because I figured that the likelihood of a state agency wanting to review a Phase I or similar document is pretty slim, and because it would probably take all night to upload all that material.
