Hi Juliet,

The intent of requesting your high-level review was to have you provide any generic direction you have for what needs to be included. Other department staff whose sections are not yet included in the Preliminary EIR either, in addition to the associated technical reports not being done, provided high-level direction for what should be included in future drafts to help streamline 2<sup>nd</sup> ADEIR review, so you were provided that opportunity as well. I am aware that you are not an archaeologist and only review historic resources-related information.

Once the report is finalized by ARG and incorporated into the EIR, there will be historic resource specific analysis. You are working with ARG directly, correct? If so, do you have a status of when that report will be submitted or it's adequacy?

Your main focus will be to review the ARG report to determine if it's adequate. I can verify that information in the report is reflected in the EIR section if you make that determination.
