Thanks! I hope you had a great weekend and are doing well. We have not received any substantial comments yet, and I need to check what was received over the weekend, but we have about eight comments so far.

Two are in support of the project. Two commenters expressed concerns, one about transportation/traffic and the other about public access through the project and riparian areas, considering the private development. In addition, Ed Ketchum suggested that we contact representatives of the Muwema Tribal Band representing this area of San Jose, per the agreement. All other comments were minor or general questions. One commenter requested to be removed from the public record but had questions about building permit requirements considering COVID.
