Dear Vice Mayor Jones,

My name is Brian Miller and I am reality capture specialist and native of San Jose. For the past ten years, I have been working to create a digital record of San Jose's historic and iconic buildings, properties and structures. Over the years, I have completed work for the City of San Jose, History San Jose, the Preservation Action Council, several for profit companies, nonprofits organizations and private property owners. In addition to my digital documentation work, each summer I host the Annual Reality Capture Engineering STEM program for students at History Park.

For the past year, I have been focused on the process of creating a digital model of the historic Diridon Station. As you know, there are plans for construction that will have major impacts on the building and the surrounding property. Given the age and condition of the facility, it is vital that we have an accurate blueprint of the building prior to any major construction.
