Hi Jose and Zak,

Could one of you calculate the acreage of the green blob outlined in red on the attached DSAP land use plan (dated 2017), please? Maybe SOM could do this the fastest.

I noticed that in the draft version the “community park” space included the triangle at the northwest corner of Bird/San Carlos, as well as the riparian corridor itself, but the approved plan shows it mainly corresponding to just the Fire Training site, which is about 4 acres. Apparently, when going from the draft to the final plan, the size of the community park noted on page 2-38 did not get updated to reflect a smaller park, nor did Figure 2-3-1 (both the draft and the final say 8 acres). We

need to get our facts straight about how much community parkland the DSAP actually calls for.
