HA-1 Based on the hazardous materials definitions provided by the San Jose Municipal Code Hazardous Storage Ordinance and California Fire Code there will be some hazardous materials stored, used, disposed of, and transported on and off site. Would provide a better description that any hazardous materials used, stored, disposed of and transported on site will be mitigated by meeting the code requirements of the City of San Jose Fire Department, the San Jose-Santa Clara Wastewater Treatment Facility, the Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health and the California Department of Transportation. For instance the batteries used for onsite generation will utilize hazardous materials.

The project may encounter underground storage tanks that may contain unknown quantities of hazardous materials. Removal of these tanks will require obtaining closure plans and removal Hazardous Materials Storage Permits with both the City of San Jose Fire Department and Santa Clara County Department of Environmental Health.

UT-1 This project may require additional water supplies and infrastructure for fire sprinklers and hydrants.
