My is James Han and I am the Planning Project Manager for the review of the Downtown West Mixed Use Project (Google). Google is considering an interim and temporary use policy within their zoning district. Some of these uses would include but not all, large-scale public/corporate events, short and long term pop-ups and pavilions, indoor and outdoor experiences, eating and drinking social spaces, art exhibitions and installations, retail, leasing for culture building and incubation, health and wellness.

The events could occur as Interim Uses contemplates uses on undeveloped parcels for s specific time period prior to or during the project's development and temporary uses would be those that will occur at post-development.
