I think that your team had some question still regarding indoor/underground collection of centralize waste collection at the Google project. I noted the following on the Google draft design guidelines and wanted to make sure you were OK with them:

Logistics, Loading, and Parking

Project-wide and individual building loading facilities allow seamless internal building function. Loading facilities require careful integration and design of the massing to avoid pedestrian safety conflicts and blank facades. Parking facilities, either located above or below grade, require vehicular access from adjacent streets. Controls for loading and parking facilities aim to reduce appearance of blank facades along non-active frontage. See Section 6.24 for more information on parking and loading access.

Standards

S5.14.3 Mitigating blank facades. Blank walls shall be designed in a manner harmonious with the building's overall composition and materials.

Refer to DDG Section 4.4.6 for additional standards and guidelines.

S5.14.4 Outdoor ramps. Outdoor ramps are prohibited in the Project. Internalized circulation is required in all cases for loading.

S5.14.5 Exposed loading bays. Exposed loading bays are prohibited.

S5.14.6 Garage entry screens and facades. Garage entries shall be screened from public views and designed to be harmonious with the building's overall composition and materials.
