Refer to the revised schedule in Table 1 of the attached PDF for processing emails and documents, which reflects the revised schedule for public circulation of the EIR. After taking a look at the OneDrive files and coordinating with the consultant (ESA), it seems that not many staff have started processing emails and documents from May 2019 to present.

The public posting of the administrative record for this project is a legislative requirement and is not optional, so please start this process right away so there is not an influx of emails and documents before public circulation of the EIR in July.

Downtown West Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Record of Proceedings

For certified environmental leadership projects, Public Resources Code Section 21186 requires the City to make the EIR record of proceedings available to the public online concurrent with publication of the Draft EIR, keep the record updated throughout the review and approval process, and certify the record within five days of project approval. In order to meet the statutory deadlines for the Downtown West Project, all City staff and consultants working on the project will play a role in maintaining the record of proceedings.

City staff shall provide relevant materials according to the following steps and the schedule in Table 1 of this document.

Step 1. Select which materials need to be included in the EIR record of proceedings

- a. Use existing City guidance related to Public Records Act requests and emails (attached to this guidance document)
 - San Jose Public Records Policy

- b. Emails and documents should be relevant to the City's compliance with CEQA or to its decision on the merits of the project.
