Hope you're doing well. Just thought you might want to see that Google is addressing C&D.

In addition, the project proposes to divert mixed construction and demolition debris to City-certified construction and demolition **waste** processors, using City-certified **waste** haulers, to achieve a **waste** diversion standard that is higher than the requirement of 75 percent identified in the City's Construction and Demolition Diversion Program (Chapter 9, Part 5 of the San Jose Municipal Code). Diverting mixed construction and demolition debris would reduce truck trips to landfills, which are typically located some distance away from city centers, and would increase the amount of **waste** recovered (e.g., recycled, reused) at material recovery facilities, thereby further reducing fuel consumption for transportation. Based on these project features, the emissions modeling and energy analysis assumes that 84 percent of **waste** would be diverted.
