Hi DSA Team,

Diridon Station Area Community Engagement – Spring 2020 Round

The City of San Jose, in partnership with community organizations, is hosting a variety of events this spring. The events will cover the range of projects and planning efforts currently affecting the Diridon Station Area, such as Google's proposed development and the Diridon Station Area Plan update. Objectives for this round of outreach/engagement are to:

- a) Continue to increase awareness of Diridon projects and decision-making processes
- b) Report back on input received during Fall 2019 round (responses to common questions, demonstrate how we are using the input, etc.)
- c) Share new information and concepts under consideration
- d) Get feedback that can inform the project review and planning processes
- e) Increase participation by population groups that are often under-represented in public involvement processes

Based on internal coordination to date, the anticipated content includes:

- a) Google Project
 - a. Updates on Project Description
 - b. Design Priorities, including more information on the anticipated building design review and approval process
 - c. Update on the DA negotiation process; Community Benefit preference exercise
- b) DSAP Update
 - a. Staff's initial proposed changes to the DSAP boundary, land use map, and height limits development capacity analysis
 - b. Draft concepts related to transportation, parks/recreation, and public space
 - c. Approach to design, infrastructure, public art, and the station concept
- c) Update on the Affordable Housing Implementation Plan and other housing-related efforts
- d) Initial assessment of the Small Business context, approach to Small Business Resiliency in the Diridon Station Area
- e) Update on the Diridon Integrated Station Concept Plan process

Most events will cover all projects and topics at a high level, with specific feedback prompts, but a couple will be focused on specific projects or topics. There are five types of events - the first three of which will be put on a flyer that the City, SAAG, and its partners can distribute to encourage attendance at these public DSA events:

- 1. City-hosted Public Meeting, with a public comment period at the end
- 2. **Community Meeting** open to the public, hosted by the City or one of our 7 community partners/grantees
- 3. **Pop-ups** at a community event (a Diridon table with info and a feedback mechanism) or **Open-house** style event where people can drop in at any time
- 4. **Community Event or Outreach Opportunity** not advertised to general public (for target population only), hosted by a community partner
- 5. **Non-DSA Events** not officially part of the City's DSA engagement program, hosted by SPUR, Google, and potentially other organizations
