My understanding is that most of the reduction in acreage reflects the removal of the proposed transit plaza associate with the Caltrain and VTA locations. The removal of this site and the refinement of open space typologies (i.e. semi-public vs riparian vs open space, etc) resulted in the net reduction of 1.8 acres of proposed open space.
