Here are some other updates:

- On December 30, 2019, Governor Newsom certified the Downtown West Mixed-Use Plan (Google project) as an Environmental Leadership Development Project under the State's AB 900 program. Per the noticing requirements, the City posted a full page public notice in the Mercury News on January 8<sup>th</sup>. - The Google Project is on the agenda for the next meeting of the Historic Landmark Commission (Wednesday, January 15, 1:00 PM, City Hall Room T-332) under the "Early Referral" Policy on the Preservation of Landmarks. The purpose of early referrals is to give the HLC the opportunity to provide feedback to staff and applicants related to historic resources to better inform project planning, facilitate the environmental review process, and make findings pursuant to General Plan policies. - As part of the presentation to [City Council on December 3, 2019 on the Diridon Integrated Station Concept Plan](#), the City Council directed staff to provide more information on the options for the southern track approach. In response, a City Council study session on the Concept Plan is scheduled for Tuesday, January 28. We will talk about the status of the Concept Plan at next week's SAAG meeting.
