

Project Description

The project requires:

- General Plan Amendment
- Planned Development Rezoning
- Planned Development Permit
- AB 900
- . . . for the development of listed proposed uses on approximately 84 acres.



Project Description continued

PROPOSED USES

GSF = Gross Square Feet

Add parks/open space???

- Up to 5,900 residential units
- Up to 7,300,000 GSF office space
- Up to 500,000 GSF active uses (retail, cultural, arts, etc.)
- Up to 300 hotel rooms
- Up to 800 rooms of limited-term corporate accommodations
 And approximately:
- 100,000 GSF event center
- 115,000 GSF for up to two central utility plants
- -100,000 GSF logistics warehouse/s



What is AB 900?

A 2011 law that enables challenges to an EIR of "Leadership Projects" to be decided within 175 days in a Court of Appeal.

Leadership Projects must:

- Be certified by the Governor's Office
- Exceed \$100 million in value
- Not result in net additional emissions of greenhouse gases
- Create high-wage, highly skilled jobs that pay prevailing and living wages
- Provide construction jobs and permanent jobs for Californians
- Sign an agreement that all mitigation measures will be enforced and monitored



What is an Environmental Impact Report (EIR)?

What is an EIR?

An EIR is a document that:

COMPLIES WITH CEQA Meets requirements of the California Environmental Quality
 Act (CEQA) to analyze physical impacts of a proposed project;

GETS PUBLIC INPUT

Has a scope of analysis shaped by public input and concerns;

LESSENS IMPACTS • Identifies ways to avoid or lessen environmental impacts through mitigation measures or impact-reducing alternatives;

INFORMS DECISIONS

 Informs decision-makers about potential impacts and the trade-offs between the proposed project and the alternatives.

Evaluation includes (but is not limited to):

- Aesthetics
- Agriculture and Forestry Resources
- Air Quality
- Biological Resources
- Cultural Resources
- Tribal Cultural Resources
- Energy
- Geology and Soils
- Greenhouse Gas Emissions

- Hazards, Hazardous Materials, Wildfire
- Hydrology and Water Quality
- Land Use and Planning
- Mineral Resources
- Noise
- Population and Housing
- Public Services and Recreation
- Transportation
- Utilities and Service Systems


