Downtown West Project Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Record of Proceedings

For certified environmental leadership projects, Public Resources Code Section 21186 requires the City to make the EIR record of proceedings available to the public online concurrent with publication of the Draft EIR, keep the record updated throughout the review and approval process, and certify the record within five days of project approval. In order to meet the statutory deadlines for the Downtown West Project, all City staff and consultants working on the project will play a role in maintaining the record of proceedings.

City staff shall provide relevant materials according to the following steps and the schedule in Table 1 of this document.

Step 1. Select which materials need to be included in the EIR record of proceedings

- a. Public Resources Code Section 21167.6 requires all written materials relevant to the City's compliance with CEQA or its decision on the merits of the project to be part of the record of proceedings.
- b. All internal and external emails, documents, and writings relevant to the City's compliance with CEQA or to its decision on the merits of the project must be submitted as part of the record of proceedings.
- c. Only emails, documents, or writings that are considered "preliminary draft" or "attorney-client communication" may be exempt from the record of proceedings. "Preliminary draft" exemption is limited to redlining/providing comments on the actual draft document where a later draft or final document will be release for public review.
- d. For purpose of CEQA, please note written materials may include any form of writing, such as emails, chat function, or texts.

Step 2. Sort materials into one of three categories and deliver to the appropriate recipient

- a. Category 1: Clearly Public materials (per City policy; no attorney privilege)
 - a. Forward these items to downtownwest@esassoc.com DO NOT PRINT EMAILS TO PDF, PLEASE KEEP AS OUTLOOK MESSAGE FILES
 - b.Note: Going forward, when sending emails you know would fall into this category, carbon-copy (cc) the downtownwest@esassoc.com inbox. They will be collected concurrently and you will not need to forward again later.
- b. Category 2: Clearly privileged materials
 - c. When a file is clearly privileged, drag the file into the appropriate subfolder for your department on OneDrive at the following link: https://sanjoseca_gov/_layouts/15/onedrive.aspx?id=%2Fpersonal%2Fshannon%5Fhill%5Fsanjoseca%5Fgov%2FDocuments%2FGoogle%20Admin%20Record%5FPrivileged.
- c. Category 3: Materials that don't fall into Categories 1 or 2

Step 3. For City Attorney office only, send processed Category 3 materials to ESA

Using ESA Deliverit

ESA's Deliverit is a file transfer service for large files up to 1 GB. If you would like to share large files with an esassoc.com email address (such as the downtownwest@esassoc.com inbox), you can use Deliverit to do so.

- 1. Navigate to http://deliverit.esassoc.com in a web browser (such as Chrome or Internet Explorer).
- 2. Enter your name and email information into the first entry boxes on the page.
- 3. Enter the recipient address into the third box.
- 4. Click the "Upload File" button. This will open a file explorer window. Select the file(s) (up to 1 GB total) that you would like to send.
- 5. Click "OK." The files may take a minute to upload.
