

Hello Community Members,

Yesterday, October 7, Google and the City reached a significant milestone for the Downtown West project by posting key documents for public review. The key documents are Draft Design Standards and Guidelines and the Draft Environmental Impact Report, along with additional documents that capture the current planning process (“updated submittal”).
