Hi Nanci, Kevin -

We've looked high and low and we could not find a copy of Terry's "ownership" map for the DSAP/Baseball Stadium. (Thank you AJ and Ruben!)

We've reached out to our retirees (Patty says "Hi") and to Development Staff in both PW and Planning without luck. I also checked with our CFAS group in case they worked on something with RDA/SARA for a conceptual elevation but no response. We also went full circle and emails were sent to Bill Ekern, lol!

Regarding fee ownership of the public streets, the standard assumption per <u>California Civil</u> Code 831 is as follows:

ARTICLE 2. Boundaries [829 - 835]

(Article 2 enacted 1872.)

831. An owner of land bounded by a road or street is presumed to own to the center of the way, but the contrary may be shown.

This seems to be the case for when Cahill was abandoned in 1935. And also for N. Montgomery and St John when they were abandoned in to build the Arena.

Per Reso 65750 (attached):

The underlying fee ownership for the subject streets is with the

Redevelopment Agency. Upon vacation, the streets will be removed

as an encumbrance upon the title and the Redevelopment Agency

will deed to the City of San Jose the Arena property.

The presumption is that Civil Code 831 was applied since RDA was the property owner on both

sides of the portions of Montgomery and St John.

As such, it is my opinion that underlying fee for other streets, in this area, would also be

vested with the adjoining property owners. (A Title Report would be needed to confirm, or

negate, that opinion.) This area is very old, with the streets established in the 1880's. This is

prior to the area being annexed into the City of San Jose and was actually in the jurisdiction of

Santa Clara County at the time.

So long story shorty....in the case of the Google Properties, if Google owns property on both

sides of the street, they would own the underlying fee to both halves of the street once

vacated.

I'm sorry we couldn't be of more help. Let me know if you have any questions.

WHEREAS, those two certain maps entitled, "PLAT MAP SHOWING THAT PORTION OF WEST ST. JOHN STREET BETWEEN NORTH MONTGOMERY STREET AND THE SOUTHERN PACIFIC RAILROAD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND PLAT MAP SHOWING THAT PORTION OF NORTH MONTGOMERY STREET BETWEEN WEST SANTA CLARA AND WEST ST. JOHN STREETS," are attached to and incorporated into this resolution as Exhibit A ("Maps"); and

WHEREAS, the Maps were approved by the Director of Public Works on January 19, 1995, as the maps showing the below-described portions of the streets which this Council declares its intention to vacate ("Streets"); and

WHEREAS, this Council is authorized to summarily vacate an easement pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of "Section 8331 Impassable street," of Chapter 4 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and

RECOMMENDATION

Adoption of a resolution summarily vacating West St. John Street between North Montgomery Street and the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way and North Montgomery Street between West Santa Clara and West St. John Streets.

BACKGROUND

The Redevelopment Agency (Agency) of the City of San Jose has requested that Public Works process an application for the vacation of portions of West St. John and Montgomery Streets, as shown on the attached map. This vacation will facilitate the Agency in their preparation of the conveyance of the Arena property to the City.

ANALYSIS

The portions of the streets proposed for vacation bisect the San Jose Arena. Demolition of structures which have been cordoned off in the Arena area began in March, 1989. Therefore, vehicular accessibility along with the need to spend public money for the maintenance of the portions of the streets to be vacated was eliminated. The streets were subsequently removed, and the San Jose Arena was constructed in the area bounded by West Julian Street, North Autumn/Montgomery Streets, West Santa Clara Street and the Southern Pacific Railroad right-of-way.

The provisions of "Section 8331 Impassable street," of Chapter 4 of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California, as amended, provides for summary vacation of

a street if it has been impassable for vehicular travel for five consecutive years and no public money has been expended for maintenance of the street during such period.

All concerned public utilities have submitted comments and have no objections to the proposed vacation. There are no public utility facilities that will require the reservation of an easement to protect present or prospective public facilities.

The underlying fee ownership for the subject streets is with the Redevelopment Agency. Upon vacation, the streets will be removed as an encumbrance upon the title and the Redevelopment Agency will deed to the City of San Jose the Arena property.

COORDINATION

The required resolution has been reviewed by the City Attorney's Office and the vacation has been coordinated with the Redevelopment Agency and the appropriate public utility companies.

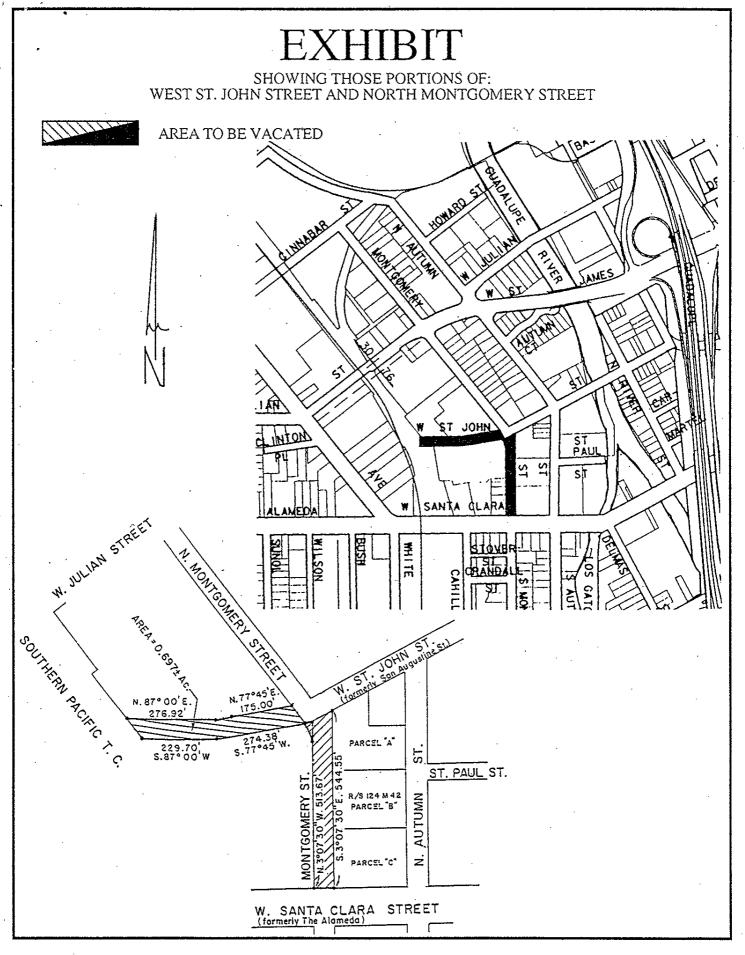

BACKGROUND

This is a request to vacate St. Paul Street between Autumn Street and Los Gatos Creek, Montgomery Street between Santa Clara Street and St. John Street, and St. John Street between Montgomery Street and its westerly terminus. These vacations will facilitate the construction of the San Jose Arena. The Department of Public Works recommends vacation of these rights-of-way because they are no longer needed for vehicular, bicycle, pedestrian, or equestrian traffic.

All affected public utility companies have been consulted and have no objection to the proposed vacation. San Jose Water Company has expressed a need to reserve an easement to protect existing facilities within St. John Street. Therefore, a public service easement will be retained over the entire St. John Street right-of-way.
