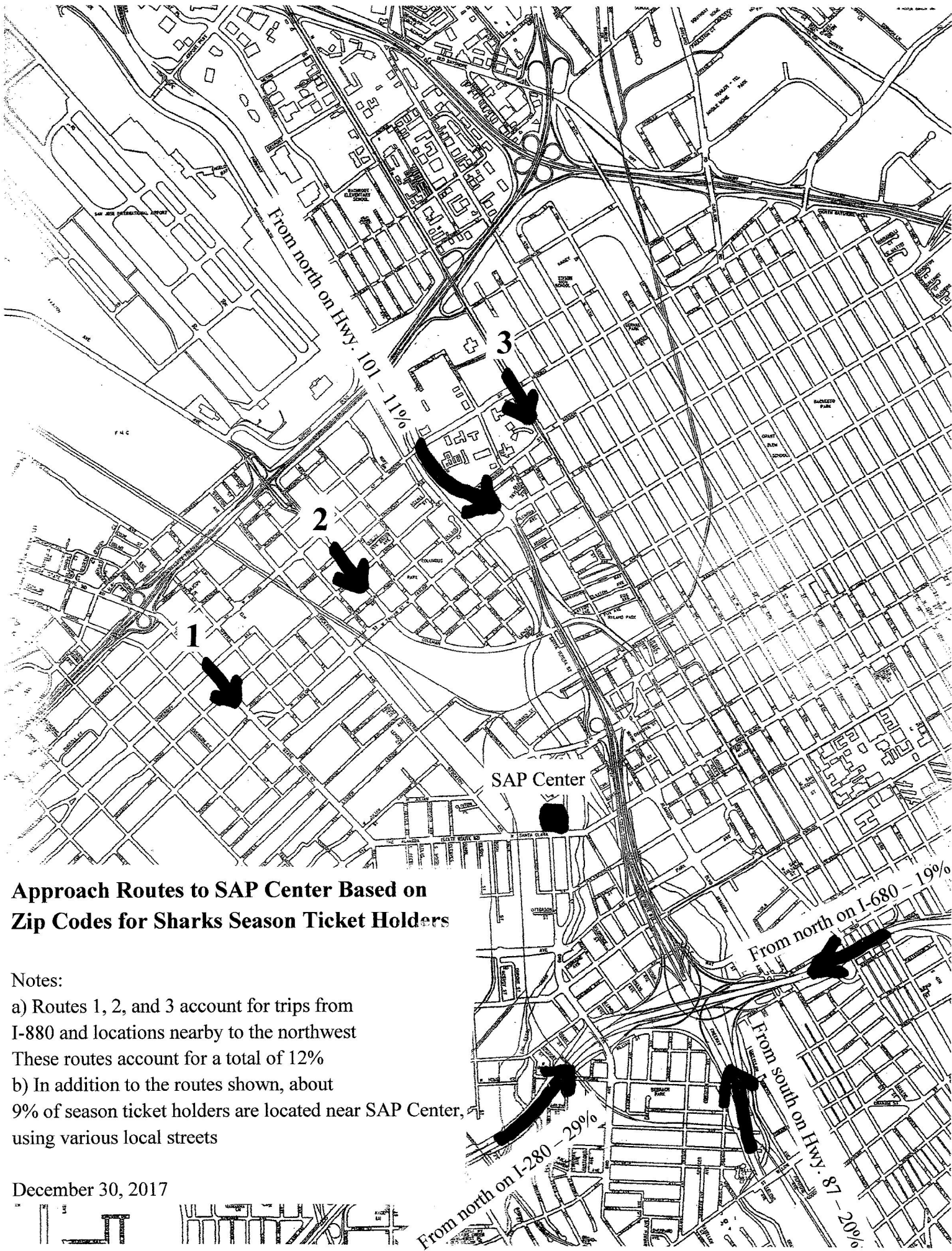

Approach Routes to SAP Center Based on Zip Codes for Sharks Season Ticket Holders

Notes:

- a) Routes 1, 2, and 3 account for trips from I-880 and locations nearby to the northwest. These routes account for a total of 12%.
- b) In addition to the routes shown, about 9% of season ticket holders are located near SAP Center, using various local streets.
