Section 4.1.2(d):

Job Readiness and Stabilization. Developer shall provide seven million five hundred thousand dollars (\$7,500,000) in funding for jobs readiness and stabilization programs. To address urgent needs for tenant protections and assistance related to the COVID-19 pandemic, three million one hundred twenty-five thousand dollars (\$3,125,000) of the total \$7,500,000 in funding (for community stabilization and ownership programs) is to be paid on or before thirty (30) days after Final Approval, as set forth in Exhibit C1. The remaining four million three hundred seventy-five thousand dollars (\$4,375,000) is to be paid on or before one hundred twenty (120) days after Final Approval, as set forth in Exhibit C1.
