I am reaching out on behalf of the parks team with the City of San Jose. It was brought to our attention recently that our team did not get the chance to review the final maintenance matrix prior to going public with it after providing initial comments.

Upon review now, it appears that at least one of the areas identified commits the City to a level of service that is inconstant with the standard services levels traditionally afforded to public parks. There was also some confusion on the acronyms that are used in the chart and do not appear to be defined anywhere else in the document.
