## **Los Gatos Creek**

The two primary areas that challenge the daylighting of Los Gatos Creek are the multiplicity of agency coordination along with regulatory complexities and design/engineering feasibility relative to cost/benefit to the project and the natural environment.

- Design/engineering feasibility of daylighting the Los Gatos Creek including the high cost to design and construct compared to the project delivering a more efficient and higher habitat improvement value by its enhanced, native replanting efforts, and other public / community benefits.
- Multiplicity of agency of coordination and regulatory complexities such as...
  - Local & State level: Valley Water, Valley Habitat Plan, CA Fish and Wildlife, Regional Water Board
  - Federal level: US Marine Fisheries, US Army Corp of Engineers
  - All of these agencies and potentially others would have to agree and sign off on the regulatory policy, design of the creek, construction plan, etc.
