## **Los Gatos Creek**

The two primary areas that challenge the daylighting of Los Gatos Creek are the multiplicity of agency coordination along with regulatory complexities and design/engineering feasibility relative to cost/benefit to the project and the natural environment.

- Design/engineering feasibility of daylighting the Los Gatos Creek including the high cost to design and construct compared to the project delivering a more efficient and

higher habitat improvement value by its enhanced, native replanting efforts, and other public / community benefits.
